Recent Changes

- This year, Target Hunger will be introducing a new online sign-up tool that will optimize convenience and accessibility.
- Unlike past years, Target Hunger will no longer be relying on area coordinators to relay information to the volunteers. All necessary information will be provided to the volunteers via the website, regular emails, as well as, further instructions given when picking up the bags.
- As a result of these changes, we hope to decrease the amount of responsibility put on single individuals, such as area coordinators or church representatives. We hope to see greater community involvement and inclusivity by using the online sign-up tool.

Route Sign-up

- To sign up for your desired route, simply visit www.targethunger.ca and click on “Route Sign-up.”
- Follow the instructions on the screen and fill out all required forms. Use the provided maps to aid you in the selection of your route as outlined on webpage.
- Once your route has been selected, you will receive a confirmation email outlining the route details including a map of your route.
- Bag pick up will be similar to past years. The confirmation email will outline your designated food bank where the bags can be picked up in the first week of June.
